WRM Season 3 Session 6

NOTE: Questions of the Week originated with a three-fold purpose. 1. They provide the Christian Educator an opportunity to send out a weekly email to parents that not only includes the Question of the Week, but can also provide information about the current WRM session and upcoming church calendar events. 2. Questions of the Week bring Sunday morning into the middle of the week (I usually send the Question of the Week email on Wednesday) by encouraging parents and their children to talk about the current WRM story. 3. To begin each class with the Question of the Week allows the students, teacher and shepherd an opportunity to get to know each other and provides a low-stress way to practice sharing.

Questions of the Week

Week 1: In the story that we'll read in class this Sunday, Jesus and the disciples are in a boat. A storm has picked up and Jesus is sleeping. So the disciples wake Jesus up, asking him for help. You've probably woken up your parents. What were some of the reasons for why you woke them up?

Week 2: In the story that we're reading in class this Sunday, Jesus and the disciples are taking a sailboat across the Sea of Galilee. Sailboats were the best kind of boat you could have at that time. Certainly better than a rowboat. What is your favorite kind of boat?

Week 3: In the story that we'll read in class this Sunday, Jesus tells the storm, "Peace! Be still." What things do you do when you choose to be still?
