



The Still, Small Voice: QUESTIONS OF THE WEEK

WRM Season 3 Session 2

NOTE: Questions of the Week originated with a three-fold purpose. 1. They provide the Christian Educator an opportunity to send out a weekly email to parents that not only includes the Question of the Week, but can also provide information about the current WRM session and upcoming church calendar events. 2. Questions of the Week bring Sunday morning into the middle of the week (I usually send the Question of the Week email on Wednesday) by encouraging parents and their children to talk about the current WRM story. 3. To begin each class with the Question of the Week allows the students, teacher and shepherd an opportunity to get to know each other and provides a low-stress way to practice sharing.

Questions of the Week

Week 1: In the story that we're reading this week, God sends a number of storms past Elijah as a reminder that Elijah is not to pay attention to the storms, but to God. There is a windstorm and an earthquake and a lightning storm that pass by Elijah -- all scary types of storms. What type of stormy weather (not necessarily from the story) do you dislike the most and why?

Week 2: In the story that we're reading this week, Elijah is reminded by God that when Elijah pays attention to the wrong things, then in his distraction, he is not able to do what he is supposed to be doing. A distraction is something that takes your attention away from what you are supposed to be paying attention to. What is something that distracts you when you're supposed to be doing chores or school work or listening to your parents?

Week 3: In the story that we're reading this week, God reminds Elijah of something Elijah already knows, but has forgotten. What's something that you already know you're supposed to do, but your parents have to remind you to do from time to time because you've forgotten?
